K.A.R. 100-2-3. President; duties. It shall be the duty of the president to preside at all-meetings of the board and perform such other duties as authorized or required by law or as may be specifically assigned by the board. The president shall countersign the minutes of board meetings when approved. The president is authorized to appoint such standing committees as the board may direct and may appoint special committees for special purposes. (a) The president of the board shall:

- (1) preside at all meetings of the board;
- (2) countersign the minutes of board meetings when approved; and
- (3) perform such duties as otherwise authorized or required by law, or specifically assigned by the board.
 - (b) The president of the board may:
 - (1) appoint standing committees as directed by the board; and
