**PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this policy is to establish “postgraduate training program[s] approved by the state board of healing arts” for purposes of K.S.A. 40-3401(r)(1)-(2).<sup>1</sup> This policy is explicitly limited to the context of K.S.A. 40-3401(r)(1) and (2) and is intended to be a guidance document pursuant to K.S.A. 77-438.

**AUTHORITY:**

K.S.A. 40-3401(r); K.S.A. 77-438.


**POLICY/PROCEDURE:**

For purposes of K.S.A. 40-3401(r), the following are “postgraduate training program[s] approved by the board of healing arts”:

- Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (“ACGME”)/American Osteopathic Association (“AOA”) accredited residency training programs
- ACGME/AOA accredited fellowship training programs
- University of Kansas Medical Center (“KUMC”) non-ACMGE accredited fellowship (“NAF”) programs
- NAF fellowship programs that are affiliated with an ACGME accredited residency program and/or are approved by their respective specialty boards
